## INTRODUCTION

GreenRADIUS is the next generation of YubiRADIUS and was developed by the same team that is now a part of Green Rocket Security. We have added additional features and updates to the already feature-rich YubiRADIUS server to ensure the most recent release of GreenRADIUS is secure against current threats.

YubiRADIUS is no longer supported by Yubico (as of November 2013) and is no longer under development nor maintained. GreenRADIUS, however, is fully supported, kept current, and has a roadmap for further enhancements.

## COMMON BENEFITS WITH GREENRADIUS AND YUBIRADIUS

Listed below are the most important, common benefits with both GreenRADIUS and Yubiradius.

## On Premise Virtual Appliance

$\longrightarrow$ Support for RADIUS, Web API, and YubiCloud authentication protocols

## Active Directory connector

## Unique Auto-Deployment

$\longleftrightarrow$ Users will be required to use two-factor authentication after first use (or when centrally enforced)
